“*Dechikonka*”! Do you know the meaning of this word? If you live in Kihoku Town in Ehime, you know that it means “Come out and join us!” The “**Dechikonka Festival*” **is* held in Kihoku in October every year. The most exciting event in the festival is the **Japanese drum contest*. You can watch and listen to the **live performances* on the first day. The big sound and **rhythm* will **shake* your **body* and **heart*. On the second day, there are about 100 **stalls* from Ehime and other **prefectures*. You can find good **souvenirs* and eat the **local food*. There are a lot of kinds of food in Kihoku, but the most famous and delicious food of all is **pheasant stew*. In the festival, they make pheasant stew for more than 2,000 people. Some people say pheasant is more delicious than **chicken*. Do you want to try it? Then just come out and **give* it a try!

Kihoku is famous for its name. The letter “ki” in “Kihoku” means “**demon*,” and it is the only town in Japan with the kanji for “demon” in the name. You can see a big **statue* of a red demon near the **town office*, and it is getting more and more popular. There is a statue of the demon’s mother in another place, too. The mother is holding her baby demon in her arms. Now the town is thinking of making another statue of a demon. What is the next demon? Is it going to be the father, brother or a blue demon?
