Shikokuchuo City is famous for its paper *industry and today it *produces the most paper products in Japan. Because they have good *quality water, the city is a *perfect place to make paper. People started to make *washi, Japanese traditional paper, in the Edo *era, and the *modern paper industry began in the Meiji era.

Every year in July, more than 1,000 people *dance in the paper festival. That's the "paper dance." Every *movement in the dance shows the *process of making paper. You can also see a *shodo performance in the festival. It originally started in the shopping streets by the *calligraphy club *members from *Mishima High School. And now it's a popular *inter-high school calligraphy performance competition after it became a movie, "Shodo Girls." In the performance, a team of high school students write messages with big brushes on a large paper four meters high and six meters wide. They dance with the music *while writing.

We don't think about paper much every day because it is always around us. For New Years you need postcards for greetings. Today you can't live without *tissues or *toilet rolls. *Newspapers and books are made of paper, too. Now you are reading this *passage, and this paper may also be from Shikokuchuo.
