The *shoya* said, "OK. I'll lend you some money, but you have to ^{*}pay it back in one month."

Kanta bought the medicine, and his daughter ^{*}got well. But he was so poor that he couldn't pay back the money. So he went to the ^{*}wisest man in the village. The man said, "How about talking with a ^{*}raccoon dog that lives on the ^{*}hill? I hear the raccoon dog lends money to people who have no money."

Kanta couldn't believe it, but there was no other way. So he climbed the hill, and found a hole on the hill. It was the raccoon dog's house. When Kanta asked the raccoon dog to lend him some money, the raccoon dog answered, "OK. I'll help you. Go home and wait."



Next morning, Kanta found a lot of money in front of his house. He was *relieved. "I can *pay back my debt." He *returned the money to the *shoya*.

From that time Kanta worked hard to make money. A month later he went to the raccoon dog's house to pay back the money. He said, "Hello!" many times, but there was no answer.
